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About Angelstone Tournaments

Angelstone Tournaments is an international equestrian show jumping venue located in the town of Erin, Ontario. The venue is 66 acres, and hosts show jumping events annually, attracting between 200-700 horses each week from all over North America. The show jumping events are open to the public with the majority of spectators visiting the park on Saturday evenings for a Grand Prix Event, ending at 11:00pm. The expected attendance range for Saturday evening events is 300-1200 spectators with the majority of traffic arriving between 5:00-7:00pm and departing between 10:00-11:00pm.

Access Points

Angelstone Tournaments has two access points in and out of the venue: **East Gate**

– **Main Entrance:** Located off Wellington Rd#50, the East Gate serves as the primary public gate throughout the Tournament. It is advised that all non emergency Fire/EMS access shall be through the East Gate. To enter the main stabling area and show office, follow the access road North to the main parking lot and continue on foot towards the West.

West Gate – EMERGENCY IN/OUT: Located off Wellington Rd#50 at the primary residence, the West Gate is designated for management and Emergency Response Vehicles only. Access to the main stabling area, competition rings and main stadium is reached by driving. The competition office is located beside the main stables at the front of the property.

Stabling units or competition experiencing a fire emergency will have been evacuated of horses by the time vehicles arrive on site. Access to each stall unit can be made from the main roadways with the furthest stall being located approximately 100' from the access point.

Tents

There are 2 hospitality tents for spectators located at the North--Central area of the venue. Tents are at capacity during Saturday evening events to accommodate the increased flow of spectators into the venue. The front of the tents is open to allow easy exits. There are two entrance/exit points for each tent with fire extinguishers at each exit point.

The Pfaff Pit Stop is 4,500 SQ FT and has a maximum capacity of 250.

The Cabana Coast Lounge is 10,000 SQ FT and has a maximum capacity of 550.

Recreational Vehicles

Angelstone Tournaments accommodates up to 48 Recreational Vehicles each week in a designated area to the East of the Main Access Road, beyond the tree line. The RVs are powered by a permanent power line running off Wellington RD 50 with 30 and 50amp service. There is a permanent road that goes through the RV area, making it easy for emergency access to reach any RV.

Hay and Shavings Storage

There are 2 tractor--trailers on--site during competition weeks that serve as storage for bales of hay and shavings. The location of these trucks is off the main access road from the East Gate.

Hazardous Materials

Angelstone does not store hazardous materials, such as pesticides on--site. There is a diesel fuel reservoir located adjacent to the green workshop at the Southwest region of the venue.

Water Supply

Angelstone does not have a system of fire hydrants; however, pump vehicles may access a supply of water in a pond located at the Northwest area of the venue to the East of the FEI Stabling Area. The pond area has a 26 HP pump that can fill vehicles. Access to the pond is also reachable with a hose 12ft or longer. We also have a water truck on site, that remains full, and can assist if needed. The property has water access at all tents and competition rings on the site.

Fire Extinguishers

Angelstone ensures that there are fire extinguishers located within all food service shelters, and spectator tents.

Emergency Personnel

Angelstone Tournaments employs one EMS personnel throughout each week of competition to administer first aid to riders and spectators.

Evacuation Route

Spectator vehicles are capable of evacuating the premises by cuing on the main access road leading out onto Wellington Road #50, while being directed by event staff. Emergency Vehicles shall be able to access and exit the venue using the designated emergency access route through the West Gate. We have three access roads across the property, that can connect the East and West road. The stabling area also has three connecting loops, creating multiple entrances and exits. All roads are done with recycled asphalt and are durable and reliable.
